The South African Society of Occupational Health Nursing Practitioners (SASOHN) Pretoria region will host SASOHN's 16th Academic Day on 12 May 2022, in a hybrid face-to-face and virtual format. In 2021, the Gauteng Central and Eastern Cape regions co-hosted the event in a hybrid format for the first time ever – an agile response to both the COVID-19 pandemic and the opportunities offered by the 4th industrial revolution. The event attracted occupational health professionals from across South Africa, as well as two international SASOHN colleagues.
